

Honoring a Trailblazer: For Women's History Month, we honor Dr.

Loretta C. Ford (1920–2025), a pioneering nursing leader whose legacy transformed healthcare forever. A World War II Veteran and internationally recognized trailblazer, Dr. Ford co-founded the nurse practitioner profession in 1965 alongside Dr. Henry K. Silver, launching the nation's first pediatric nurse practitioner program. Her visionary approach to nursing education and holistic care reshaped the role of nurses and expanded access to healthcare, particularly in underserved communities. As the founding dean of the nurse practitioner program at the University of Rochester, Dr. Ford empowered generations of nurses to lead with innovation and compassion. Her impact continues to shape the profession and inspire more than 355,000 nurse

practitioners today.
