Thank you from the bottom of my heart for your support, your kindness, and the meaningful work we have accomplished together. It has been an honor to serve as your Alumni Director.



lasting legacy of mentorship and excellence. Beyond her professional achievements, Barbara will be remembered for her warmth, energy, and generosity of spirit.


Our thoughts are with her family and loved ones as we honor her remarkable life and contributions to the Upstate community.
