Alumna Dances in Worldwide Competition

The "Dancing with the Stars" contest has nothing on one Upstate alumna's experience competing at the highest level internationally for ballroom dance. **Ilona Prouty**, **PT '98**, and husband Andrew, represented the U.S. dancing the rumba and other Open Latin Division styles at the World DanceSport Federation World Championships in Salsomaggiore, Italy, last November.

"There were 82 couples and eight heats – the size of this competition was something I never remotely experienced!" commented Ilona, who is also the founder and president of the Syracuse Chapter of DanceSport USA. The duo has 15 years together on the dance floor.

Ilona's enthusiasm for dance began in Poughkeepsie where she started ballet lessons at age three and

later starred in her high school musical. Dance, however, took a back seat as she obtained a degree in psychology and worked as a school youth counselor. When she came to Syracuse years later for her master's in physical therapy, her love of dance was rekindled at ballroom dance parties, where she also met Andrew.

What transpired was a whirlwind of dancing together socially, performing at dance exhibitions and, ultimately,



"a surprise marriage proposal before 200 of our dancing friends. We competed for the first time on our honeymoon in 2005," Ilona noted. "We dreamed of winning a national competition together."

In April 2013, they did just that at the USA Dance Senior 2 National Latin Championship in Los Angeles. The call came last September to compete across the Atlantic.

Placing better than midway – 40th – was more than they anticipated in their first, such highlevel competition. "Our ultimate dream became a reality," she said. Ilona also felt privileged to be one of two selected to recite the Athlete's Oath during the opening ceremonies.

According to Ilona, her combined experience in PT and dance makes for "perfect synergy" in her PT job at

Crouse Hospital. Specializing in treatment of vestibular and balance disorders, "I use my critical eye as a dancer to identify minute deviations in movement patterns. I have taken my dance training techniques or exercises, such as turning skills, and adapted them for my patients." Conversely, she believes, "the in-depth knowledge PTs possess of the body, especially anatomy, has given me an advantage to learning proper ballroom dance technique."


ALUMNI CLASS NOTES

FACULTY UPDATES

A four-year study funded by the National Institutes of Health to determine treatment for a common flatfoot disorder is being led by **Christopher Neville PT, PhD**, associate professor of Physical Therapy. The Upstate clinical trial will test various ankle braces used to treat flatfoot due to Posterior Tibial Tendon Dysfunction in adults over 40. Findings will determine which brace design is most successful for clinical use and provide insight for future device development.
